SEP 28 TUE ARRIVE JOHANNESBURG, SOUTH AFRICA

Upon arrival in the "City of Gold", you are met and assisted to your reserved hotel, located in the airport complex, opposite the arrivals terminal.



ACCOMMODATIONS: AIRPORT SUN INTER-CONTINENTAL JOHANNESBURG

This hotel has an excellent location just 50 metres from arrivals and departures at Johannesburg International Airport, and is the only hotel within the airport offering five-star facilities. Hotel features include 24-hour front desk service, concierge services, laundry/valet services, video checkout, duty-free shopping, car rental desk and airline boarding desk for participating airlines. Baby-sitting service is available on request. Early check-in and/or late check-out, as well as express check-out features are offered. Covered garage parking is available.

Accommodations include luxury guest rooms, executive rooms and suites. All rooms are air-conditioned, and have interactive TV system offering airline flight information, satellite TV, direct dial telephone, voice mail and wake-up call facility. The work desk has a modem connection and cell phone re-charger. Bathrobes are provided as well as a hairdryer, coffee/tea maker, separate wardrobe, private bathroom plus shower, and mini bar.

The hotel has a first class restaurant with an informal atmosphere, offering modern cuisine, from breakfast through to late-night a la carte dining. The cocktail bar is an ideal meeting place for the international traveler. In-room dining with an optional 'flight-friendly' menu is available.

There is a health and relaxation center with gymnasium, indoor pool, steam bath and a masseur to soothe away the tensions of air travel. Golf and tennis are nearby.

On Federal Air flights each passenger is allowed one (1) item of luggage to a maximum weight of 20 kg. (44 lbs.). The **luggage should be soft sided** to allow for easier packing. You may store any excess baggage at the Federal Air Terminal in Johannesburg, for collection by you after your game reserve stay.

JOHANNESBURG / MANYELETI GAME RESERVE

After checking out of your hotel this morning, make your way to the Federal Air booth in the Bus Terminus at the Johannesburg O.R. Tambo International Airport, located behind the Intercontinental Hotel. A Federal Air representative will meet and assist you to the Federal Air Terminal and Lounge for the departure of your flight to your safari lodge.

You will be met on arrival and transferred by road to your safari lodge. Relax and get settled-in to your safari lodge before the afternoon game viewing drive.

MANYELETI GAME RESERVE

With no fences separating these reserves, the huge variety of wildlife – over 105 different animal and 450 bird species roam free across the game reserve. Wildlife sighting at this safari lodge is sure to be good.

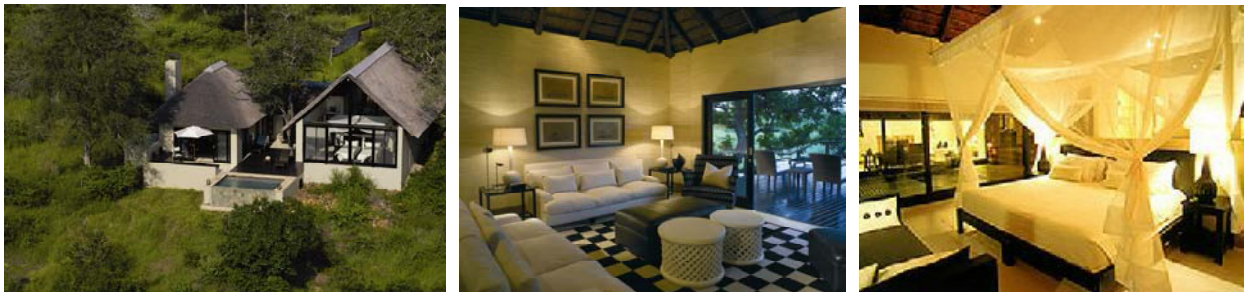
Lion Sands Private Game Reserve is situated in the Southern portion of the 254 square mile Sabi Sand Game Reserve (southern Kruger National Park region), an area well known for its spectacular game viewing.



Lion Sands has exclusive access to the Sabie River. From its source high up in the Drakensburg mountain range where it passes through the famous Mac Mac falls, the river through Lion Sands teems with wildlife. It is the definitive safari experience. The relatively cool riverbanks offer a brief respite from the relentless African sun. Splendid parades of animals pass through to quench their thirst at the water's edge. And eager predators wait patiently.

The name 'Sabie' comes from the Zulu 'eSaba', meaning 'afraid'. Both man and beast approach the river with care and respect. It is at once a sanctuary of life and a gripping display of survival. It is what visitors from all over the world come to experience: raw, untouched nature. In ancient days, the lush Sabie river basin was overrun by Africa's largest reptile, the Nile crocodile. Today, they bask in the shallows in slightly less numbers, still snapping their deadly jaws at any creature wading in close enough.

Of course, your safari cannot be complete without exposure to every facet of life in the bush. With the highly informative and holistic approach at Lion Sands, you will encounter all spheres of the eco-system, from the smallest insects to the mighty African elephant. ACCOMMODATIONS: LION SANDS IVORY LODGE

Lion Sands Private Game Reserve is situated in the Southern portion of the 65,000-hectare Sabi Sand Game Reserve, an area well known for its high concentration of wildlife through both the dry and wet seasons. The Southern boundary is shared with the Kruger National Park along 10.5km of Sabie River frontage with the wildlife moving freely across the river, between the two reserves.

The property's geographical location is an area of great diversity of both fauna and flora and affords us unique activities based around the river system and surrounding area. Lion Sands is situated in one of the most pristine wilderness areas in Southern Africa.

Lion Sands Ivory Lodge is exclusive in its pristine location overlooking the magnificent Sabie River. It has been decorated in an old African style, the feeling being cool, light and minimalist.

For the traveler who is looking for a more secluded & private experience Ivory Lodge is the recommended camp. Characteristic Species of the areas are lion, elephant, white rhino, leopard, cheetah, buffalo, giraffe, zebra, hyena, waterbuck, hippopotamus, crocodile, wildebeest, kudu and many other mammal & bird species.

Each of the luxurious air-conditioned rooms offers en-suite bathroom, indoor & outdoor shower, a lounge with fire place, patio, private game viewing deck and private plunge pool. All rooms also have telephones and internet access.

Amenities also include a private guest lounge, sundeck and bar, swimming pool, health spa, curio shop, indoor and open-air (Boma) dining areas, a private Sala, two river hides and a waterhole hide.
